



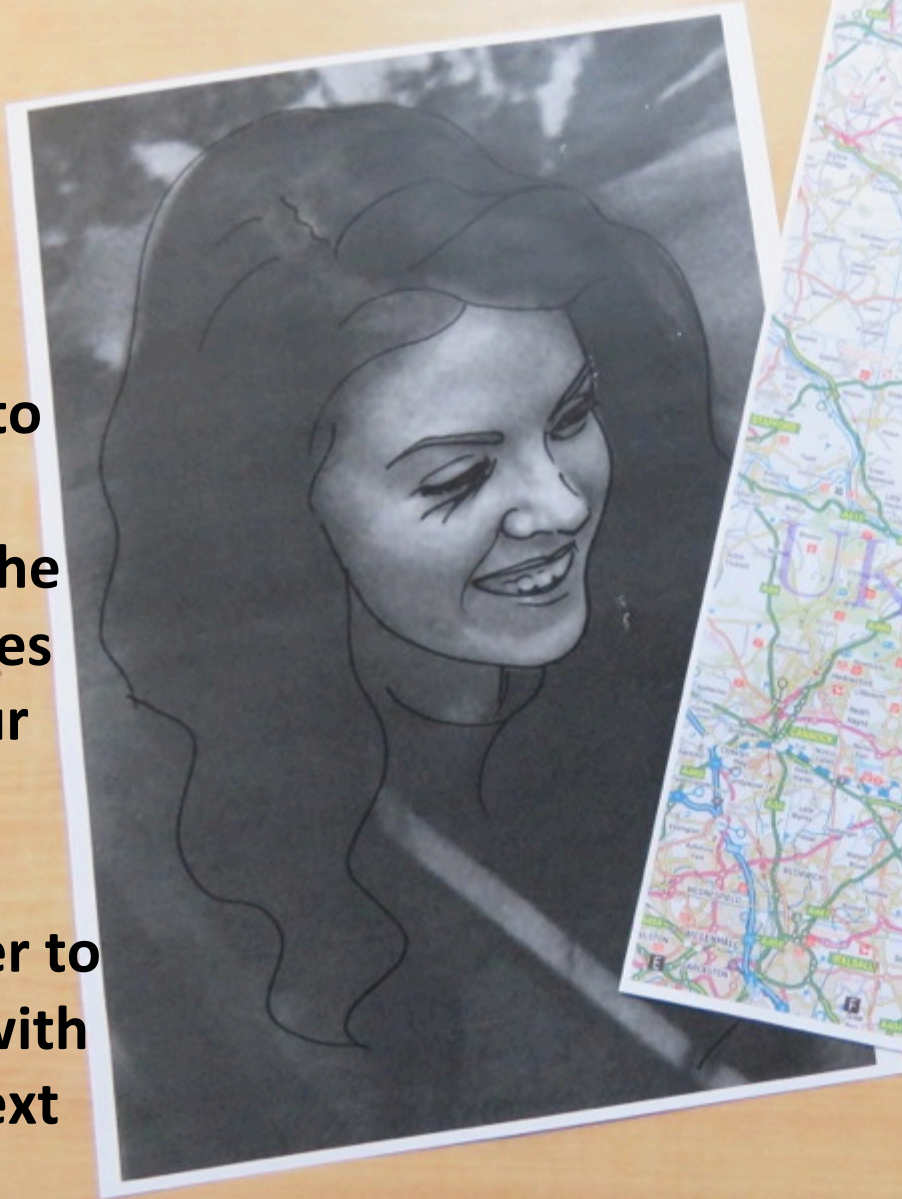
Creating a

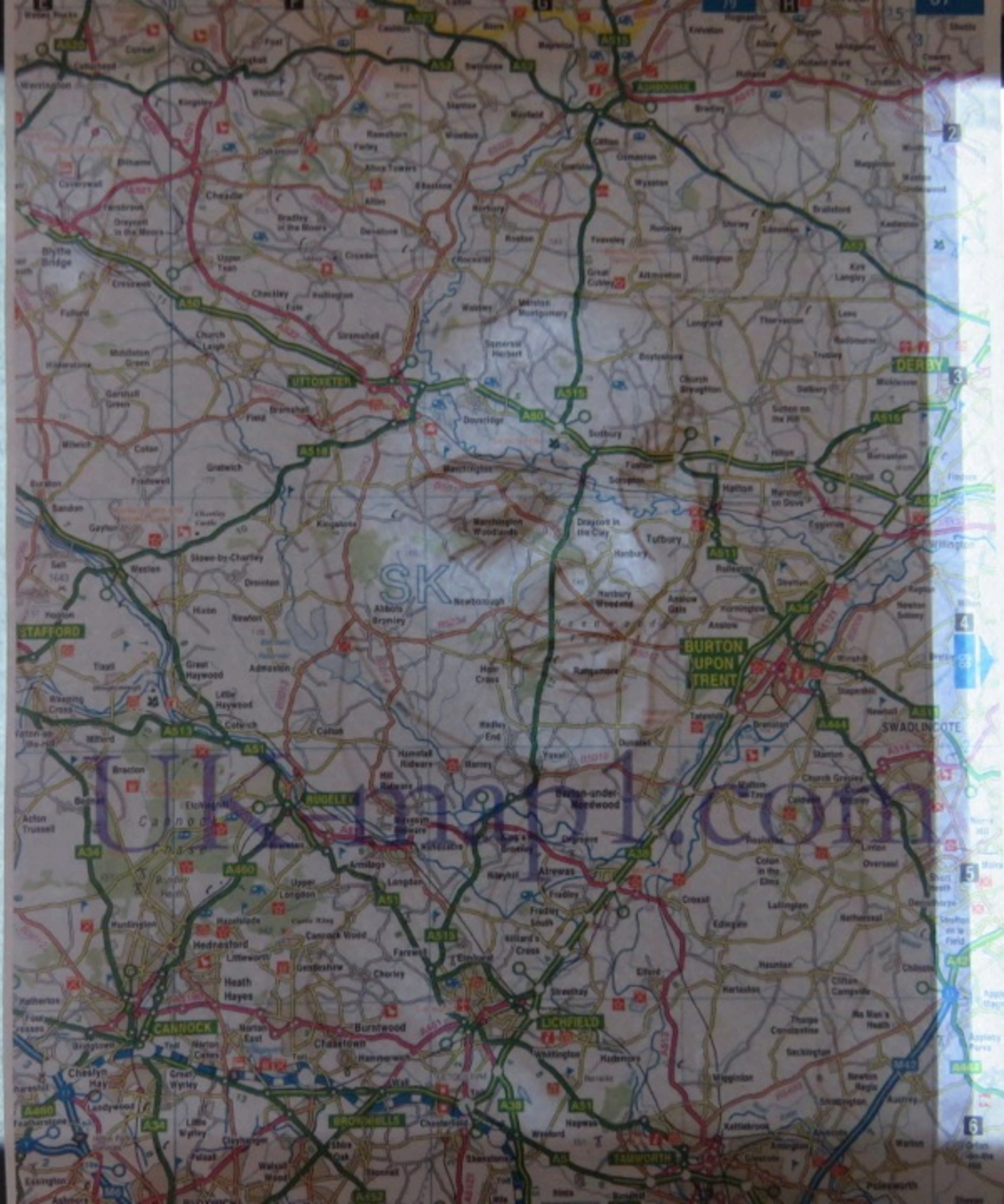
Portrait

**Print an A3 photo of you / someone and a high quality image of a map of where you / they are from.**

**You might need to draw over the outlines of your photo with a marker to help with the next stage.**

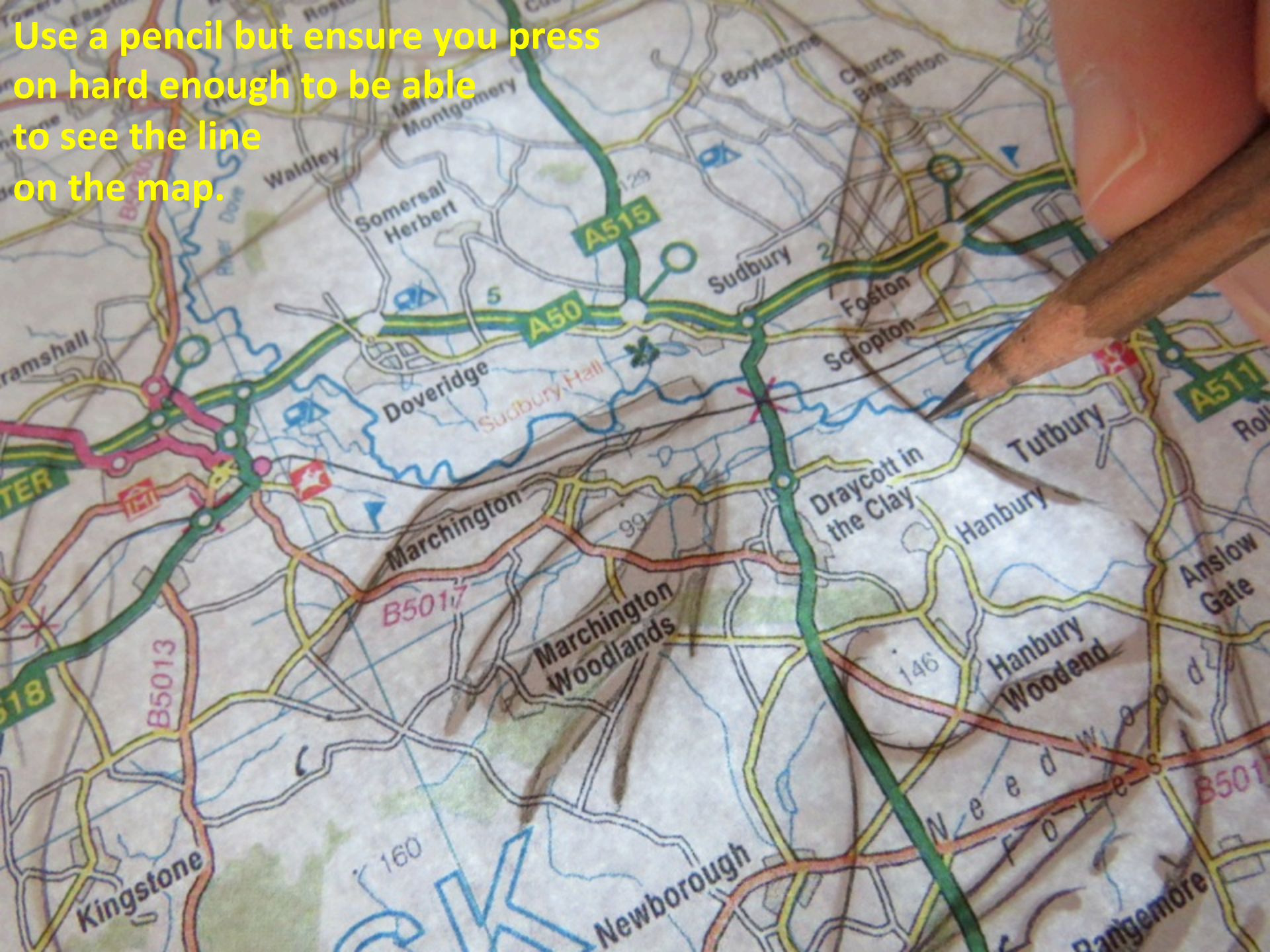


Use the

the face.

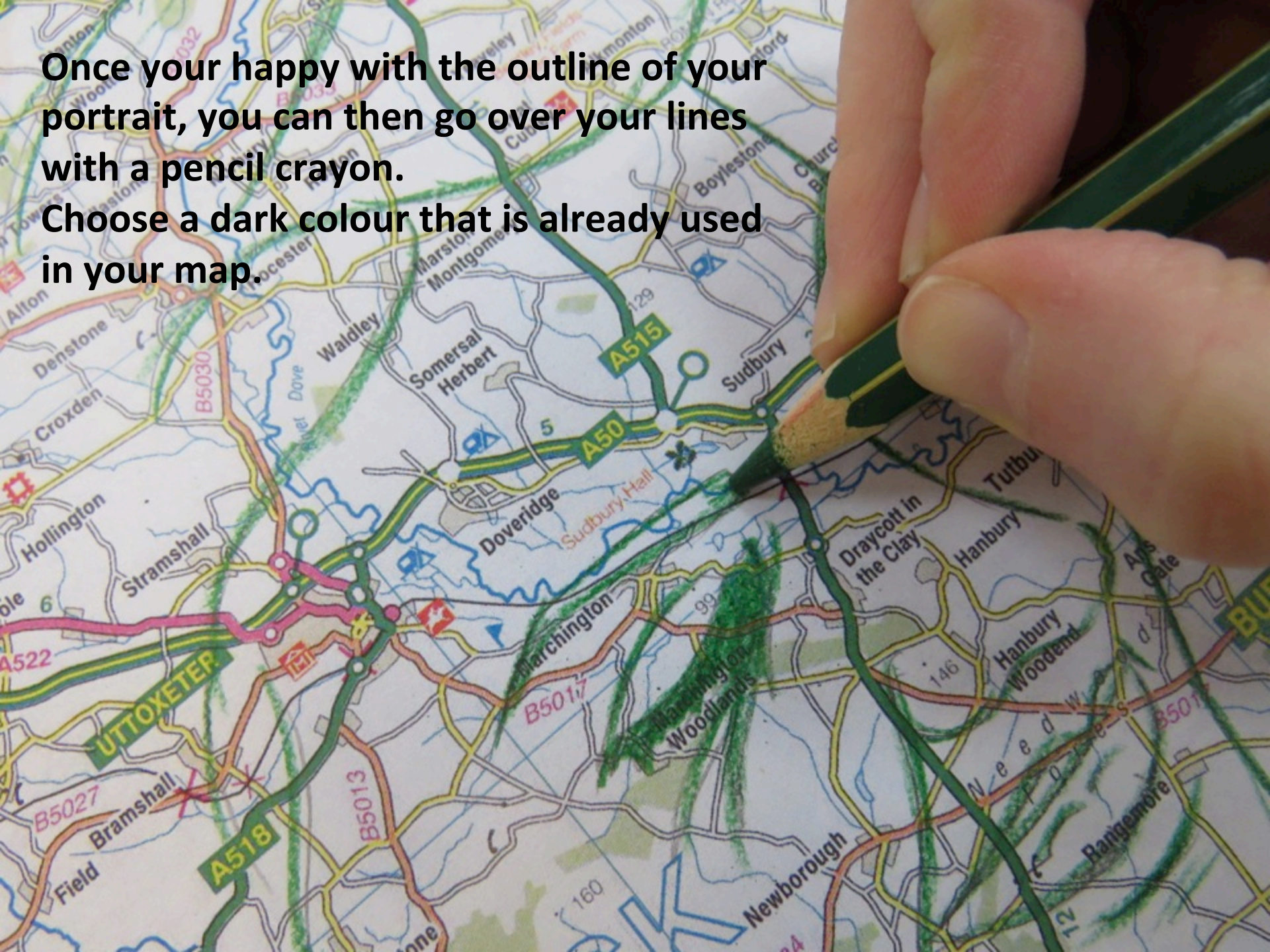


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Use a pencil but ensure you press on hard enough to be able to see the line on the map.



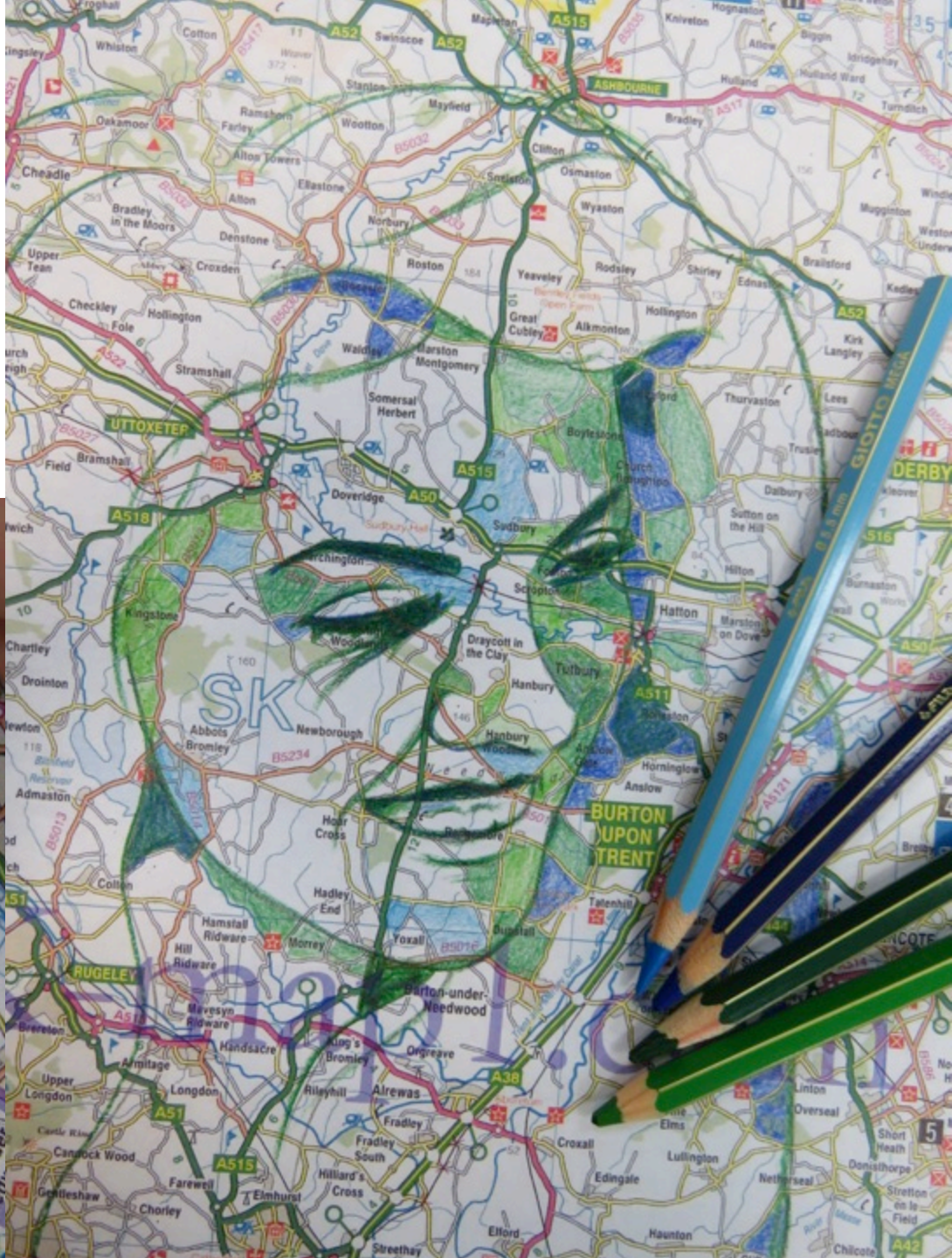
Once your happy with the outline of your portrait, you can then go over your lines with a pencil crayon. Choose a dark colour that is already used in your map.





You should then have something that looks like this.

Use colours already used in the map to shade in sections to suggest tone. i.e. use the darker blue for the shadows of the face and the lighter blue for the mid-tones. Leave the lightest tones.





You should then have something that looks like this.



You can then use a knife and a cutting board to carefully cut out sections of map to represent highlights.





**When you have cut out your highlighted areas, you can experiment with different backgrounds.**



You might decide to keep it simple, by using white underneath to show the highlighted area.
